RULES AND REGULATIONS

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society. NPS rules for showing apply.

Riders of stallions must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year. All riders while mounted must wear correctly secured current British Standard skull caps/riding hats.

Foals must be over 4 weeks of age on the day of the show and must accompany the mare into the ring.

Neither the organisers of this event, nor any agent or representative thereof accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness or any other loss of any kind whether financial or otherwise suffered by any horse, pony, spectator, land, buildings, person, animal or any other property of any type whether caused by negligence, breach of contract, breach of trust or in any other way whatsoever.

It is a condition of entry that all exhibitors shall, to the extent allowed by law, indemnify this Show and Myerscough Equine College, its Officials, Servants and Assistants against all actions, proceedings, claims or otherwise in relation to or arising from his/her entries in the Show, and each online entry/ form made as having accepted these conditions.

The Committee reserves the right to cancel, amalgamate or divide classes as and when necessary. The Committee reserves the right to accept substitute ponies.

ANY PONY TAKING PART IN CLASSES AT THIS SHOW MAYBE LIABLE TO RANDOM DRUG TESTING

It is strongly recommend the wearing of body protectors for jumping competitors.

All horses and ponies should be vaccinated and have the minimum of their annual booster or had their 2nd inoculation within a minimum of 7 days before competing at Myerscough College. If in doubt, please consult your vet.

QUALIFIERS AND AFFILIATIONS

NATIONAL PONY SOCIETY (S5.089) Qualifiers for 2024 Summer Championship Show.

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part bred are not eligible mountain and moorland classes. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 6th – 8th August 2024. The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified. NPS/Corscaron Horse Essentials Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

NPS SILVER MEDAL ROSETTE CHAMPIONSHIPS: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 6th – 8th August 2024.

THE BSPS NEW HORIZON PLASTICS HERITAGE MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP.

Ponies, Owners and Riders need not be B.S.P.S. Members to compete in the Breed Semi-Final qualifying classes, but pony, owner and rider will need to register to compete in the SEMI-FINAL to be held at the B.S.P.S. "Heritage" Championship Show 19th & 20th October 2024. Classes will be judged under B.S.P.S. rules as per the 2024 B.S.P.S. Rule & Show Handbook. Animals must be the correct height for the breed as laid down in the individual breed standards.

The B.S.P.S. encourages members to have their hats tagged through the B.S.P.S. scheme or via the Pony Club Scheme. (We are accepting British Eventing, British Riding Club and Pony Club tags) Please see BSPS RULE BOOK 2024.

THE TAM O'SHANTER IN-HAND CHAMPIONSHIP

This show is a qualifier for the Tam O'Shanter In-Hand Championship to be held at the BCPS Annual Breed Show, Moreton Morrell Equine College 19th -20th July 2024. The 3 highest placed ponies in Classes 1-4, 6 & 8 not already qualified will qualify for the finals qualification to go no lower than 6th place.

NCPA

This show is a qualifier for the NCPA Pony of the Year Show 2024. 1st and 2nd Prize-winners in the appropriate classes will qualify. Cards will be handed out in the ring. Visit www.thencpa.co.uk for membership and more information about how to enter.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to complete the forms correctly.

Entries will be accepted by post provided they are made on the correct forms and the cheque is sent immediately to the Secretary.

Exhibitor's numbers will be collected from the Secretary's Office on the day of the Show. Entries will be invalidated if the accompanying cheque is not cleared. Entries on the day are available to ponies that are already pre entered.

CATERING will be available. Please keep the showground tidy and use the litter bin provided. Do not muck out horseboxes/trailers on the showground. Please Park where directed.

DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES. Do not tie horses to the side of horseboxes or trailers.

STABLING: To be arranged directly with Myerscough College. There is very limited stabling available please contact the venue direct on 01995 642115 it will be on a first come basis.

DIRECTIONS: Travelling by road from the South: Leave the M6 at Junction 32 (Broughton, Preston), the junction incorporates the M6 and M55 motorways and the A6 trunk road. Care should be taken to filter left following the 'A6 Garstang' lane indicators. On joining the A6 , follow the 'Garstang' signs for 3¾ miles to a large sign on the left hand side of the road naming 'Myerscough College', and turn left along St Michaels Road. The College is ¾ mile along this road and involves a right turn halfway through an S bend.

Travelling by road from the North: Leave the M6 at Junction 33 (Hampson Green). On joining the A6 travel south following 'Preston' signs for about 9 miles to a large sign on the left-hand side of the road, naming 'Myerscough College', and turn right into St Michaels Road. The college is ¾ miles along this road on the right, just after a sharp left turn.

ATTIRE: Correctly secured Skullcaps/Riding Hats that meet current Safety Standards/specifications MUST be worn by all Riders of all ages please see **NPS** Rule Book. Handlers of ponies in In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear a correctly secured skull caps/riding hat that meets current standards.
The NPS strongly recommends body protectors are worn in all NPS jumping competitions especially over fixed obstacles.

Classes 1-4,6-8 are qualifiers for the **NPS/MOLEVALLEY FARMERS In Hand Home Produced Championships** Please see NPS Rule Book, Sec A, 3.6. Please enter this class in the spirit it is intended. Competitors who contravene the above will be disqualified.

These classes are open to pure bred registered M&M ponies in the main body of their studbook. Owner's membership cards must be shown in the ring to receive qualifications. Foals are not eligible.

Class 13

Nursery Novice Ridden Pure Bred, Part Bred and Over Height Connemara

Open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old and over

A pony is deemed a Nursery Novice if it is in the first year of competing in ridden classes and has not won a novice ridden class by the 1st January 2024. Ponies will only be required to walk and trot together but may canter in their individual show. Snaffle bridles only. There will be separate rosettes for the pure bred and part bred/over height ponies please can all riders of part bred/over height ponies wear an armband.

Class 14

The NPS/PICTON STUD M&M Novice Ridden National Championship (MM-NR)
To be judged under NPS rules 2024

Open to pure bred Connemara stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over. A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following:

- i. Won an open affiliated mixed M&M Ridden class
- ii. Qualified for Horse of the Year Show, LIHS or RIHS Open M&M Ridden classes
- iii. Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship show (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided, they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year).
- iv. If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show, LIHS or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final.

Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.

No rider may ride more than one pony in a class except that riders in all WHP and Arena Eventing classes (excluding training stakes) that are not qualifiers for HOYS or RIHS may ride up to two ponies of the same height in a class, and both ponies can go forward for show and conformation judging. There must be no change of rider between the phases.

The NPS/ M&M Novice Working Hunter Pony National Championship (MM-NWHP) To be judged under NPS rules 2024.

Open to registered pure bred M&M stallions, mares and geldings, four years old or over.

Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit. A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following:

- i) Won an open affiliated WHP class
- ii) Qualified for Horse of the Year Show or RIHS Open WHP classes
- iii) Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate WHP final at the NPS Summer Championship show (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year).
- iv) If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de noviced and cannot compete in the Novice WHP Final.
